## TREND 01

# Acceleration in AI Disruption Will Evolve the Way Organizations Scout for Talent

### WHAT'S CHANGING

The convergence of AI, cloud, and automation is reshaping the talent landscape at an unprecedented pace. India's tech sector is expected to cross the \$315 billion mark in FY26, adding 135,000 net new jobs and taking total direct employment to nearly 6 million. This is a clear marker of continued growth even as hiring patterns shift structurally.

### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Competition will no longer centre on acquiring generic talent; it will concentrate on securing high-value, niche capability pools that are in constrained supply and rising demand. Top skills in demand include AI/ML engineering, cloud architecture, cybersecurity, and GenAI development.

### FORECAST

Organisations will need to transition their talent acquisition approach from volume hiring to value hiring, prioritising depth of capability over scale. This shift will require a reimagined job-selling strategy that moves from conventional role marketing to showing candidates exactly what they will own, build, and become, giving high-value talent a reason to lean in.

## TREND 02

# The AI Talent Wars Will Be Won by Organisations That Harness the Strength of Their "Innovation" Brand

### WHAT'S CHANGING

Demand for AI-skilled talent is expanding 2.5 to 3X faster than supply. Emerging tech roles such as AI, generative AI, and machine learning can command up to 43% as a skill-based pay premium, making AI the most compensation-inflationary segment in the tech workforce. Senior AI roles are seeing 2X higher attrition. Organisations are competing not only on pay but on access to advanced computing, high-quality data and meaningful problem statements.

### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

AI talent selects employers based on innovation credibility. Specialists join environments that offer autonomy, complex challenges and visible ownership of models and outcomes. Traditional employer branding carries limited weight unless backed by technical substance and a mature AI ecosystem.

#### FORECAST

The battle for AI capability will intensify, concentrating top talent within organisations that demonstrate clear AI ambition, strong engineering foundations and pathways for experimentation and impact. Companies unable to offer this will face escalating hiring costs and persistent capability gaps.

#### TREND 03

## Employee-Generated Transparency Will Redefine Employer Brand

#### WHAT'S CHANGING

Employee voice is becoming the most influential force shaping employer reputation. Individuals now command global reach through platforms like TikTok and Instagram, where "work-life reality" content regularly attracts millions of views, often outperforming corporate brand campaigns. Trust dynamics have shifted sharply, with people placing 3x more trust in employees than in CEOs when evaluating an employer's credibility. More than 55% of organisations now use social media as their single most-used recruiting strategy ahead of compensation improvements, flexible work offers, and job board advertising, forcing companies to rethink how they show culture instead of simply telling it.

#### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Company culture and the lived employee experience are becoming the brand. Social platforms increasingly reward unfiltered, behind-the-scenes content, elevating authentic creator voices over polished corporate messaging. Salary transparency, day-in-the-life stories and workplace call-outs are becoming mainstream. The rise of the "citizen-journalist employee" signals a new era in which governance shifts from content control to narrative partnership, and campaigns give way to employee-first reputation building.

#### FORECAST

Employee-generated transparency will become a dominant force in employer perception. Organisations that invest in experience, psychological safety and open dialogue will gain reputational resilience, while those relying on controlled storytelling will face widening credibility gaps. Employer branding will evolve from brochure-style communication to experience-led narratives shaped collaboratively with employees.

## TREND 04

---

### Flexi-Talent Shall Become the New Fulcrum of Workforce Strategy

#### WHAT'S CHANGING

A persistent shortage of upskilled talent is driving organisations, especially GCCs, toward elastic workforce models. Flexi-talent is expanding at pace, with 1 in 4 GCC roles projected to be contractual by 2026. Demand for agile hiring frameworks is rising 2-3X as transformation programs accelerate. The strongest surge is seen in digital and project-based pods that require specialised expertise deployed rapidly.

#### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Workforce elasticity has shifted from a cost lever to a strategic capability. Flexi-talent ecosystems now underpin the execution of complex initiatives, enabling organisations to tap niche skills on demand and maintain velocity without long-term headcount commitments. For professionals, these models offer accelerated portfolio-building exposure across high-impact mandates.

#### FORECAST

Elastic workforce strategy will become a core operating principle for high-growth enterprises and GCCs. Flexi-talent will shift from being a supplementary resource to becoming foundational for delivering complex, future-critical initiatives. Organisations that rapidly build agile sourcing channels and capability marketplaces will gain a decisive advantage in speed, specialisation, and project competitiveness.

## TREND 05

---

### The Growth-Efficiency Tightrope

#### WHAT'S CHANGING

Organizations are pursuing aggressive growth while navigating technology transformation, economic uncertainty and margin pressure. HR is being pushed toward zero-waste headcount models, lower fixed hiring costs and a higher mix of variable or flex talent. Projections through 2027; GenAI will require 80% of the engineering workforce to upskill. Starting in 2028-2029, AI is expected to drive the need to reconfigure, redesign, and fuse over 32 million jobs each year, reinforcing the urgency of workforce transformation today.

#### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Workforce strategy is shifting to a disciplined balance of cost and capability. The emerging 20-60-20 model: 20 per cent core roles, 60 per cent hybrid skill roles, 20 per cent elastic talent, reflects the need for a more adaptive workforce. High-value talent is gravitating toward organisations that show how they protect growth while safeguarding people during volatile cycles.

#### FORECAST

Organisations that integrate cost efficiency with capability depth and scalable capacity are projected to outperform their peers by up to 3x in productivity. Employer value propositions will increasingly emphasise adaptability, future skills and strategic resilience over traditional notions of stability.

#### TREND 06

## With the Emergence of the Entrepreneurial Graduate, Organisations Will Reinvent Themselves as Accelerators of Intrapreneurship

#### WHAT'S CHANGING

Graduates entering the workforce are reassessing how they view work, risk and long-term stability. With organisations reporting mixed expectations for AI's impact on workforce size, 32% anticipating reductions, 43% expecting no change, and 13% predicting career uncertainty is rising. This environment, combined with lower barriers to launching ventures through AI and no-code tools, is accelerating a shift toward independent and portfolio-style career thinking.

#### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Early-career talent increasingly seeks environments that operate as launchpads rather than ladders. Founder-like roles, faster learning cycles, and broader exposure to problem-solving are becoming more attractive than linear pathways. Skill volatility and less predictable headcount are reshaping how graduates assess career opportunities, with many viewing entrepreneurship as a parallel or primary track to traditional employment.

#### FORECAST

Organisations that position themselves as accelerators of entrepreneurial capability will attract the next generation of high-ambition talent. Roles designed around ownership, experimentation, and rapid upskilling will outperform traditional development models. The graduate landscape will continue to shift toward hybrid identities: employee, builder, and creator, driven by AI-enabled agility and a growing appetite for autonomy.

## The Recruiter Role Shall Be Rebuilt for the AI Epoch

### WHAT'S CHANGING

AI is automating large portions of the hiring workflow with automated sourcing tools, having reduced time spent on top-of-funnel prospecting by approximately 50%. As a result, recruiters are spending less time on transactional tasks and more time navigating complex, future-critical roles that carry 2-4X longer hiring cycles. The function is shifting from process execution to strategic talent advisory.

### WHAT THIS DISRUPTION MEANS

Recruitment is becoming a brand-defining touchpoint rather than a back-office process. Human connection, insight and judgment are emerging as competitive advantages. Recruiters are evolving into Talent Intelligence Partners, responsible for capability mapping, skill evaluation, market insights, and long-term relationship-building. As AI scales efficiency, the human layer is being repositioned as the differentiator for high-value hires.

### FORECAST

Recruiter roles will move upstream, becoming integral to workforce planning, market intelligence and strategic hiring decisions. Organisations that invest in recruiter upskilling and position the hiring experience as a core brand asset will gain stronger traction for hard-to-fill, high-impact roles. AI will manage the workflow; recruiters will manage the narrative, relationships, and outcomes.
